TRI-STATE T.E.C. CODE OF CONDUCT

We are here to serve and to praise God through word and action. These rules need to be honored by every team member & candidate.

1 You are asked to attend all team meetings prior to the weekend. Absences are discouraged. Any absences must be cleared with the Adult Coordinators (ACs) prior to being gone. No more than one absence will be allowed. Unexcused non-emergency absences are not allowed.

2 No driving after the weekend begins without permission from the adult coordinators.

3 Team members will refrain from displaying overly affectionate behavior toward other team members or Candidates. Couples will be warned by the ACs if inappropriate behavior is observed during the weekend and team meetings.

4 T.E.C. is a tobacco free activity. No Smoking, vaping, etc.

5 Sleeping is required and allowed only in the designated male and female sleeping rooms, not in common areas or in the team rooms.

6 Team members are expected to remain in their work area and perform tasks as directed by the team leadership. Team members are reminded that they are unable to attend talks as a guest during the weekend; any special requests must be approved by the ACs prior to the weekend.

7 Team members are encouraged to leave cell phones at home. Any phones brought to the weekend must not interfere with responsibilities of the weekend. If they become a problem, they may be confiscated and returned Sunday following closing.

8 Cameras, other than the weekend photographer, are only allowed in Team Only areas. The use of cameras should not interfere with your responsibilities on the weekend.

9 Team members are expected to help with the church cleanup on Sunday. Wheat bags will not be distributed until the church is clean.

10 All music played during the weekend must be Christian music. The ACs, Rector, and Rectora must approve all secular music with a Christian message before the weekend begins.

11 Team members & candidates are reminded to wear appropriate clothing to all team meetings and the weekend. Our focus is always God's unconditional love for us and our attire shouldn't detract from that. Violations of the dress code will be addressed by the ACs.

12 Team members and candidates will be respectful in conversations throughout the weekend. Report uncomfortable situations to an adult.

13 Team members should not post to Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, or any other social media site during a weekend. Once you're at the church on Thursday afternoon, know that social media can wait until after the weekend so as not to distract you from serving during the weekend, which also includes the closing & church clean up. Any team members found posting on social media sites during the weekend will be ineligible to work the next weekend.

As a member of the team, you are expected to abide by all of the above items. Failure to do so could result in dismissal from the team. Please see the Parental Consent form for further information on how violations of this contract will impact your involvement at future TEC weekends. **Most of all, the TEC Council wants you to have fun while serving and praising God.**

Tri-State TEC Clothing Policy

If you are on team or are a Candidate, your clothing has the potential to influence people's perception of you and more importantly Christ. Choosing modest clothing helps to avoid distractions and misunderstandings. You are asked to choose apparel consistent with the following guidelines during team meetings and at the weekend:

Please Bring

- **Clothing That Follows the 4 B's:** NO BREASTS, NO BUTTS, NO BOXERS (or undergarments of any kind), NO BELLIES
 - **All shorts for males and females must exceed your fingertips when arms are placed on your sides and abide by the 4 B's rule stated above**
- **Loose-Fitting Clothing.** Bring clothes that you are comfortable in. During the weekend you will want to be comfortable, you will sit a lot so having clothing that allows for movement and comfort will help keep you energized. This also applies to sleep wear.
- **One-Piece Swimsuits.** Some TEC weekends include swimming activities. Please choose modest, one-piece, swimsuits for these occasions. If you do not bring a one-piece for swimming, you'll be asked to wear a dark t-shirt over it. Please note that although there won't be swimming every weekend, swimsuits are a good idea for additional privacy in the showers.
- **Closed-Toed shoes for team members working in the kitchen.** To prevent injury, you need to bring a pair of shoes that completely cover your foot.

Please Don't Bring

- **Tank tops, shirts, or dresses with spaghetti straps.** Shirt or dress straps must be at least three fingers wide. Dresses with thin straps must be worn with a sweater. For boys cutoffs must include a seam around the arms.
- **Clothing that reveals undergarments, midriffs or too much of the chest.**
- **Pants that ride too low and reveal undergarments**
- **Tight-fitting clothing** including leggings, yoga pants, etc. Leggings or yoga pants may be worn underneath shorts/skirt or a shirt that abides by the 4 B's rule.

Apparel that ...

- Includes obscene, vulgar, abusive or discriminatory language or images
- Advertises or promotes alcohol, chemical, tobacco or any other product illegal for use by minors
- Represents hate groups, is gang-related, or contains threatening language

Why Is This Clothing Policy Important?

Each person represents Christ in the communities that s/he belong in, including the TEC community. While those outside of TEC may choose to wear these clothing items, wearing them can work against efforts to serve as the hands and feet of Jesus. It is for this reason that you are asked to refrain. This distracting apparel can be disrespectful and damaging to long-term relationships and our TEC community.

Your youth and adult leaders do not want to be the "clothing police" during the TEC weekend. You are asked to abide by this clothing policy. Anyone may ask an adult or youth leader to enforce the policy by asking you to change your clothing if it is believed to be a distraction.

Your help is appreciated for creating a safe, respectful, distraction-free environment for your TEC experience.

As a member of the team, you are expected to abide by all of the above items. Failure to do so could result in dismissal from the team. Please see the Parental Consent form for further information on how violations of this contract will impact your involvement at future TEC weekends. **Most of all, the TEC Council wants you to have fun while serving and praising God.**
